Duties: Community Health Worker (CHW) provides individual client care coordination, home visiting services, and referrals to needed services by:

- Providing women and their families with individualized social support to encourage and reinforce health promoting behaviors and goal setting strategies
- Helping women and their families understand the importance of a healthy lifestyle and to prepare for the future (peer education)
- Developing an individualized program for each woman based upon her life course stage
- Providing home-visiting services, risk assessment and client centered service plans and referrals
- Working collaboratively with CHW Supervisor and MISN's Women's Health & Wellness Program Manager in systems-building efforts to coordinate and strengthen collaborations among providers within the community and other community-based organizations, ensuring women of reproductive age and their families have access to continuous and coordinated health care and other needed services.

Qualifications: Candidate must have a valid NYS Driver's License and reliable vehicle as travel is required to cover Sullivan and Ulster County communities. Bilingual Spanish –English preferred and must be familiar with communities to be served.
